Day 1: Arrive Cape Town

Day 2: Sightseeing in the City of Cape Town

Charly's Bakery, home of Charly's Cake Angels, you hear a brief history of District Six en-route to a visit at the

Company Gardens. Learn more about the history of the Bo-Kaap and its people as you move up the cobblestoned hills to the Malay Quarter, where you'll marvel at the ice-cream colours of the quaint Bo-Kaap homes. Finally, trace the moves of a professional diamond cutter as he creates every girl's dream stone. Return to the V&A Waterfront and enjoy the afternoon at leisure. Your guide will recommend gluten free dining options for both lunch and dinner.



Day 3: Cape Town's Cape Peninsula

On this day, you'll enjoy a full-day private tour of the CapePeninsula. It will include lunch at a local restaurant with gluten free options available.



Cruise along Millionaire's Paradise from Clifton to Camps Bay and on to Llandudno before enjoying an up-close-and-personal Seal Island cruise. Wind along Chapman's Peak Drive with lunch at Cape of Good Hope Section of the Table Mountain National Park before meandering back along the coast, visiting Simon's Town and the penguin colony at Boulder's Beach.
